Terms of Reference

Chair: Chairing arrangements on a rotating basis amongst the three statutory partners: Police, Local Authority and CCG. The chair will then lead for the quarter following the Executive meeting

Purpose of the Executive

- Provide strategic leadership for the development of services for children and young people in North Somerset
- To develop multi-agency approaches to support children and young people to develop and grow
- To develop more preventative services to support children, young people and families
- To agree an annual plan to further develop services for children and young people
- To monitor and review existing services and identify potential improvements

Membership

Core Membership will be the three statutory partners who are the decision makers:

- Director of Nursing and Quality; BNSSG CCG
- Director of People and Communities; Local Authority
- Senior Police Officer who is Area Commander for North Somerset; Police
- Partnership Liaison Manager, Lighthouse Unit; Avon and Somerset Police

In addition, one of the following members to represent the Partnership Leads Group:

- Partnership Liaison Manager, Lighthouse Unit, Avon and Somerset Police
- Strategic Safeguarding and Quality Assurance Service Leader, Local Authority
- Head of Children's Safeguarding; BNSSG CCG

Members are required to provide a substitute to represent them if they are unable to attend for any reason.

Others may be asked to attend the Executive in order to provide specialist information.

Quoracy; in order for the Executive to be quorate there will need to be at least a representative from Health, Police and the local authority present.

Frequency of Meetings

The Executive will meet quarterly. Additional extraordinary meetings will be arranged if required.
